Indian National Congress, 1931 (Karachi Session) In 1931, the Congress met at Karachi and approved the Gandhi-Irwin Pact. The most significant contribution of the Karachi session was a resolution it passed on Fundamental Rights and Economic Policy. It was later known as Karachi Resolution. The Karachi session was presided by then INC President Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. The Session was conducted in the shadow of three major events. First, Mahatma Gandhi had just been released from prison following his Salt Satyagraha. Second, the Gandhi-Irwin pact had just been concluded which had brought the civil disobedience movement to an end and third, the British government had, a week before the session, executed Bhagat Singh and two of his associates in connection with the Kakori Conspiracy case. The DAV Sreshtha Virtual Conference would encourage the delegates to go through the books of history and look into this significant matter of interest of our constitution makers.

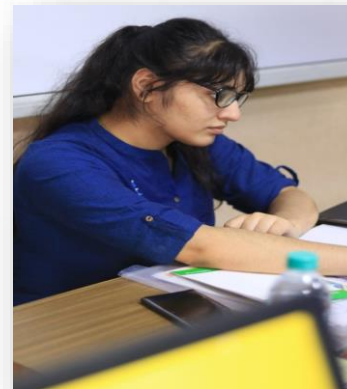

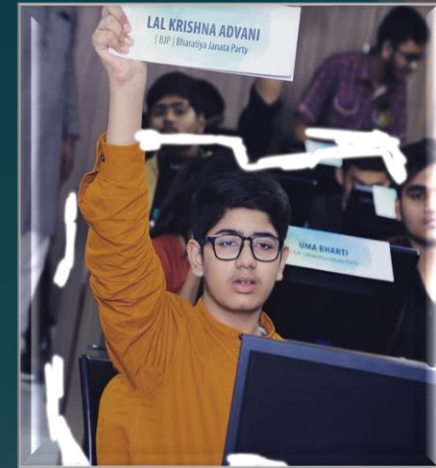
